# Proceedings of the 5th Annual General Body Meeting of UVCE Graduates Association (2025)

## Communication and Attendance

The AGM was held on July 27, 2025, at BHive Premium, Church Street, Bengaluru. The meeting notice was shared via email, WhatsApp, and published in Deccan Herald and Prajavani on June 30, 2025. A total of 56 UVCEGA members from various batches attended.

## Opening Session

The day began with informal networking. Due to low initial quorum, the meeting was adjourned and resumed at 11:20 AM with quorum met. The Secretary welcomed members, followed by a moment of silence for departed alumni.

## Meeting Proceedings

The Secretary, Mr. Satish, read the AGM notice and led the obituary observance. President Mr. Srikanth opened the meeting, ratified minutes from the 4th AGM, and introduced the agenda. The ratification was unanimously approved.

## Membership Updates

Vice President, Lt. Sukumar Rao announced the milestone of 2,000+ registered members. He highlighted top contributing batches and urged alumni to improve outreach.

Mr. Vaidhyanathan (1980) suggested using social media for better engagement.

## Governance & Institutional Strengthening

Mr. Sukumar discussed improvements in financial oversight with system-driven accounting and a dedicated accountant. He stressed structured EC processes, long-term sustainability, and transparent documentation.

## MARVEL Lab Updates

Execom Committee member, Mr. Adrian explained MARVEL's role in driving student innovation. Over 180 students completed Level-1 courses; Aviation was added as a specialization in Batch 6. Work has begun on MARVEL 2.0.

Mr. Dwarakanath (1966) thanked the initial seed donors ie. 1963-64 batch alumni.

## UVCE Sammilana

Mr. Satish presented the Engineers Day event held on Sept 22, 2024, with 80+ attendees at the Century club, Bengaluru.

## Utthirna Graduation & Alumni Induction

Mr. Adrian detailed the Aug 17, 2024 event for 2022 - 2024 batches, initiated by Prof. Paul and UVCEGA President Mr. Srikanth. The event turned into a symbolic reunion reflecting UVCE pride.

## New Initiatives

Mr. Satish introduced the Young Alumni Achiever Awards presented during Utthirna.

He also recapped the Proud UVCEian 5K Run held on Mar 16, 2025, which witnessed 750 participants. A special mention was given to the sponsorships as well.

## Scholarship Update

Joint-Secretary, Miss Meghashree shared that ₹ 16.6 Lakhs was disbursed to 86 students. The process was explained and donor acknowledgments made. 10 Endowment Funds currently support the initiative, with efforts to expand.

### **Reunions**

Mr. Satish emphasized how UVCE Batch reunions help increase memberships and contributions. In the last year, UVCEGA supported reunions for 1974 Batch, 2014 Batch, and 1975 Mech.

### **Infrastructure Projects**

Mr. Sukumar outlined past projects and future collaboration plans. Refurbishment of the UVCE Board Room cost ₹ 17.5K. Waterproofing at Boys' Hostel was completed. Website management continues under VisionUVCE and current team leadership. Governance and maintenance tracking were positively noted.

### **Alumni Engagement & Student Support**

Mr. Satish spoke on:

- Mentorship Program (June 2025–Jan 2026) pairing students with alumni.
- Quarterly meetings for updates and announcements.
- Benevity partnership since 2023–24, aiding donation inflow.

### **Finance Report**

The Treasurer, Mr. Muralidhara shared the audit report, including income, expenditure, and current balance.

The report was proposed by Mr. Vaidhyanathan (1980 Mech), seconded by Mr. B. R. Somashekar (1980 Mech) and Mr. Kamesh (1971).

### **Plan for 2025–26**

Mr. Srikanth presented the UVCEGA roadmap for the upcoming year. Key priorities were outlined as follows:

UVCEGA 2025–26 Plan – Quick Highlights

- **Alumni Engagement & Growth:** Drive memberships via reunions, Meet N Greets, and UVCE Sammilana (Engineers Day event).
- **Student Support & Development:** Continue scholarships and mentorships, increase endowment funds, assist with placements and higher studies, and strengthen Student Alumni Co-ordinators.
- **Innovation & Infrastructure:** Upgrade MARVEL Lab, promote project development, and initiate Innovator Forge—a contest connecting students and alumni.
- **Community Building & Networking:** Organize milestone reunions, monthly alumni meetings, and social events like Alumni Soiree.
- **Entrepreneurship & Career Advancement:** Develop a startup support network and enable opportunities for internships and skill-building.
- **Communication & Digital Presence:** Continue Sampada and UVCE Chronicles, and enhance the UVCEGA website.
- **Organizational Strength & Vision:** Appoint batch coordinators, launch fundraising drives, and define the long-term growth plan for UVCEGA and UVCE.

### **Budget Presentation**

Mr. Muralidhara shared the budget for 2025 - 26.

The previous year's budget Plan and Expenditure were taken into consideration and the Budget Plan for

2025-26 was created and further approved. This Plan was presented by the Treasurer along with the expected income and outflow.

### **Closure**

Mr. Srikanth concluded the AGM officially at 13:04 and opened the session for Q&A.

## **Proceedings of the Special General Body Meeting of UVCE Graduates Association (2025)**

The President, Mr. Srikanth opened the quorum for SGM meeting 2025.

The Secretary, Mr. Satish mentioned the changes on the by-law which were discussed in detail and approved unanimously.

Here are the details:

Advisory Committee Role Clarification: A wording update was proposed changing “deciding the roadmap” to “advising on the roadmap,” affirming that the Executive Committee (EC) retains control and accountability under the by-law. The clarification was read aloud by Mr. Satish; unanimously approved after Mr. Srikanth called for a show of hands.

Committee Term Finalization: Mr. Srikanth proposed a 5 year term for Advisory Committee appointments. Mr. Vaidhyanathan suggested a 3 year term instead, which was supported by Mr. Sridhar and Ashok M. L. It was finalized as a single 3 year term and it was unanimously approved.

Executive Roles Structure: The EC will comprise:

- 1 Secretary
- 1 Joint Secretary
- 1 Treasurer
- 1 Joint Treasurer (New addition)

This updated structure was read by Mr. Srikanth and unanimously accepted.

Advisory Committee Appointments: Committee members were announced and their appointments were unanimously seconded by attendees. Below are the names of the announced and confirmed.

Mr. Srikanth called for closure of the SGM. This wound up proceedings for AGM and SGM of 2025. A vote of thanks was given by the Execom Committee member, Mr. Sridhar and the event was followed by lunch.

## Proposed vs Accomplished – Overview

- **UVCEGA Subcommittees:** We had proposed a few key subcommittees like Academia Relations, Industry Collaboration, Sponsorship & Fundraising, Events & Alumni Connect etc aimed at strengthening the association’s initiatives. This has not materialized much and we hope to revive in the future.
- **Sammilana 2025:** We continued the tradition of celebrating the Engineers Day and also identifying the Young Alumni Achievers from UVCE. However, there were some more plans announced in the last year like Lifetime Achievement and Distinguished Alumnus Awards, Alumni Wall of Honor, showcasing of student innovations etc were not realized. We will work on these ideas in the future
- **MARVEL 2.0:** We were successful in relocating the MARVEL Lab to a bigger space and launch BRIDGE initiative to promote a culture of innovation and entrepreneurship across departments. However, it has to be taken forward to realize the goals like product development and incubation.
- **UVCEGA Scholarship Program:** For the year 2025-26, a total of 16.5 Lakhs was disbursed to 74 students (out of proposed 20Lakhs). Creation of new batch-wise and memorial endowments to secure long-term funding was achieved.
- **Fundraising:** Strategic fundraising was one of the key focus area for 2025–26 to ensure continuity, expansion of UVCEGA programs. The idea was to cross 1.5 Crore in cumulative corpus out of which we have achieved 1.4 Crores. A targeted “UVCE Impact Fund” was not launched, but instead of we raised specific initiative-driven funds (Boys Hostel, MARVEL, Scholarships, Water Filter etc)
- **Enhanced Governance and Transparency:** We have streamlined the communications and tried to have interaction with the members on a regular basis in order to keep the functioning of the Association open, democratic and transparent. However, the website upgradation is something that has to be worked upon.
- **Student-Alumni Connect:** Initiatives like UVCEGA Mentorship for Scholarship Awardees; CareerSutra, Placement BootCamp, PULSE Talks etc have been organized successfully. These programs have helped students to navigate career choices and gain insights from alumni across sectors. Some other programs (Unnathi, SheSpeaks etc) are to be worked on to grow in both scale and impact.
- **Alumni Network & Events:** Batch Reunions (Golden, Silver, Decade Celebrations); Meet N Greet (Informal catchups); Hostel Visits; UVCE Parva (Felicitation of distinguished Alumni Achievers) were organized successfully.

## Detailed Report for the year (2025-26)

### Membership

We are proud to share that the UVCE Graduates Association has crossed the significant milestone of **2,150 life members**, marking a strong and growing alumni community. This achievement reflects the collective effort and commitment of our team to deepen engagement across generations of UVCE graduates. Several targeted initiatives have contributed to this growth — from **on-campus outreach drives for graduating batches**, to **focused campaigns during reunion events** such as 2015 batch reunion, 2000 batch reunion and 1975 batch reunion. We also leveraged **digital outreach tools**, including personalized emailers, WhatsApp broadcasts, and QR-code-based registration links shared during events like **UVCE Sammilana**, **CareerSutra** and others. Additionally, alumni-led peer referrals and our consistent

communication through *Sampada*, *UVCE Chronicles*, and social media helped build trust and visibility. As we move forward, this 2100+ strong member base not only strengthens our collective voice but also lays the foundation for greater alumni-led impact across UVCE's academic, innovation, and student support initiatives.

## Governance and Institutional Strengthening

Over the past year, UVCEGA has strengthened its governance framework with a focus on professionalism, transparency, and accountability. With the corpus fund crossing ₹1.4 crore, the association has introduced more structured financial and operational processes, including system-driven accounting, regular budget monitoring, and defined authorization protocols. Simultaneously, communication and decision-making processes have been streamlined through formalized channels, documented proceedings, agenda-driven meetings, and established governance practices. These efforts reflect UVCEGA's commitment to building a robust, sustainable, and professionally managed organization that inspires confidence among its members and stakeholders.

## MARVEL – Lab

Over the past 5 years, MARVEL (Multi-disciplinary Applied Research, Validation, and Engineering Lab) has strengthened its position as a flagship initiative of UVCEGA, empowering UVCE students to drive innovation, solve real-world challenges, and develop industry-relevant skills through hands-on learning and research.

With an investment of nearly ₹25 lakh so far, MARVEL has established a strong foundation for student innovation by providing state-of-the-art infrastructure, alumni mentorship, and a structured, multi-level learning framework. During the past cycle, more than 250 students successfully completed Level-1 certification, gaining hands-on exposure to emerging fields such as AI/ML, Design & Prototyping, IoT, and Aviation. The lab also conducted several workshops, guest lectures, and project review sessions led by experienced alumni, fostering a vibrant, collaborative, and multidisciplinary learning ecosystem. The students have participated and won awards at various competitions.



With the launch of the BRIDGE initiative, the focus will progressively shift towards enabling deeper research, advanced project tracks, capstone innovation sprints, startup ecosystem linkages, and product-thinking frameworks that help transform student ideas into real-world solutions. We are also exploring collaborations with leading engineering institutions, innovation hubs, and CSR-supported partners to further expand the lab's reach and impact. As part of this journey, students have actively participated in various industry events, workshops, exhibitions, and field engagements, gaining valuable exposure beyond the classroom. In this way, we plan to strengthen

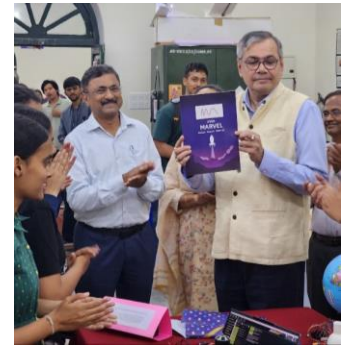
UVCE's position not only as a premier academic institution but also as a vibrant launchpad for future-ready engineers, technologists, researchers, and entrepreneurs.

Akash is currently serving as AI Product Manager at tiramai ai. His achievements extend far beyond the corporate world. In 2018, he founded Military Mantra, a YouTube channel that today inspires over 250,000 defense aspirants across the country, helping them prepare for careers in the armed forces. His commitment to

shaping young minds has also earned him the YouTube Silver Play Button. He co-founded the Super Dream Foundation, a citizen-led initiative that brings joy and support to children in orphanages across Bengaluru. In addition, Akash serves as a Traffic Warden with the Bengaluru City Police, playing his part in making our city safer and more livable.



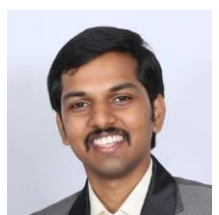
***Aparajitha Murali (Electronics and Communication Engineering, 2011)***

Aparajitha Murali is currently a Backend Developer with Unik Consultants, where she also consults with ETA Technology Pvt. Ltd. She is a National Masters Gold Medalist in Swimming, with over 30 state-level medals and 8 national medals to her credit. She has represented Karnataka in open water swims and stood on the podium in prestigious events such as the Goa Swimathon and the National Masters Aquatic Championships. She is also a triathlete who has participated in multiple events. She is also an ICF PCC trained coach, breathwork & meditation teacher, helping individuals cultivate inner peace, resilience, and mindfulness through her workshops and personal coaching.



***Anabelle Viegas (Architecture, 2011)***

Anabelle holds a Master's degree in Computational Urban Design from The Bartlett School of Architecture, UCL, where she graduated with distinction. She is the Managing Director of Dmello Creative Systems & Services, and the founding partner of Think Happy Everyday (THE) — a design philosophy and practice that intersects art, architecture, communication, and culture to create experiences that make people truly happy. In 2016, she co-founded CityLab Bengaluru, a research collective of urban designers, planners, sociologists, and academicians. Across all her initiatives, Anabelle has consistently blurred the boundaries between architecture, research, culture, and social impact — making her not just a designer of spaces, but also of experiences and ideas that bring people together.



***Sri Krishna Bhogaraju (Mechanical Engineering, 2010)***

A University Gold Medallist and First Rank holder from Bangalore University, Sri Krishna pursued his Master's in International Automotive Engineering from the Technische Hochschule Ingolstadt in Germany, specializing in automotive design and electronics. His academic excellence was recognized with the Bayerische Stipendium from the Bavarian State Government. In 2023, he co-founded CuNex GmbH in Germany, where he now serves as Co-Founder and CEO. CuNex develops breakthrough copper-based bonding technologies for microelectronics, optoelectronics, power devices, and battery systems. Beyond his professional journey, Sri Krishna has also contributed as a DAAD Young Ambassador, guiding Indian students aspiring to study in Germany, and as a Teach India volunteer, committed to education and social impact.

These recognitions reflect the growing legacy of UVCE alumni and the immense potential they carry to shape the future. UVCEGA remains committed to spotlighting such achievers and inspiring generations to come.

## **Remembering DR M R Srinivasan**

The UVCE Graduates Association, in collaboration with UVCE, organized a heartfelt Remembrance Day on 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2025 to honor the legacy of Dr. M. R. Srinivasan, an alumnus of the 1950 Mechanical Engineering

batch and one of India's foremost pioneers in nuclear energy. The event brought together a distinguished gathering of dignitaries, faculty, alumni, students, and members of Dr. Srinivasan's family, all united in tribute to a remarkable life dedicated to science, technology, and nation-building.

His leadership spanned key positions such as Chairman of the Atomic Energy Commission, Secretary of the Department of Atomic Energy, and Senior Advisor to the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA). He was instrumental in conceptualizing and executing the country's first nuclear power plants, and his vision helped set India firmly on the path to energy self-reliance.

UVCE Director Prof Subhasish Tripathy and UVCEGA President Srikanth reflected on Dr. Srinivasan's inspiring journey from the classrooms of UVCE to the heights of global scientific leadership. Adding emotional depth to the tribute were reflections and memories shared by a host of distinguished guests including Prof. Shailesh Naik (Director, NIAS), Padma Shri Prof. Sharada Srinivasan (NIAS), Prof. Jayant Murthy (Indian Institute of



Astrophysics), and Prof. Srikant, Prof. Soundarrajan, and others from NIAS. Members of Dr. Srinivasan's family, his wife Mrs. Geetha Srinivasan, son Mr. Raghuveer Srinivasan, daughter Prof. Sharada Srinivasan, and brother Mr. Srivatsan were also present and shared heartfelt messages, making the ceremony especially poignant.

## **“BRIDGE” Launch & Announcement of Sir M. Visvesvaraya Entrepreneur & Startup Fellowship**

On 25th November 2025, a landmark occasion at UVCE — the Launch of “BRIDGE – Building Research & Innovation, Driving Growth & Entrepreneurship” and the Announcement of the Sir M. Visvesvaraya Entrepreneur & Startup Fellowship, a major step toward strengthening UVCE's innovation and entrepreneurial ecosystem was successfully organized by UVCEGA.

This event brought together distinguished leaders, innovators, faculty, students, and alumni to celebrate a transformative milestone for our institution. We had the privilege of having the Guests of Honour:

- Mr. Naganand Doraiswamy, a seasoned entrepreneur, venture capitalist (1989 alumnus)
- Mr. Vaidyanathan A, innovator, entrepreneur with multiple patents to his credit (1980 alumnus)
- Maj. Gen. Neelakantappa, decorated veteran of the Indian Army (1963 alumnus)



The event emphasized the institution's commitment to nurturing a culture where ideas transform into prototypes, solutions, and impactful ventures for society. BRIDGE combines two complementary hubs MARVEL (Innovation & Research Hub): Applied research, prototyping, experimentation, and collaboration with faculty and alumni mentors and E Cell (Startup & Ideation Hub): Ideation, validation, pitch training, and early stage venture development with industry and alumni entrepreneurs.

Together, MARVEL and E Cell create a complete innovation pipeline, enabling students to transform ideas into ventures and positioning UVCE as a dynamic powerhouse for engineering, innovation, and entrepreneurship.

### **Financial Assistance to students for participating in Hackathons & International Conference**

We supported the students to participate in Smart India Hackathon, a national-level competition for which this team has been shortlisted out of the 60 other teams that had participated from UVCE. A total of 6 students travelled to attend the Final Round at Jaipur on 7<sup>th</sup> December, 2025. From UVCEGA, we extended the support to the students to help book their flight tickets (worth around 1 Lakh). It was a Blockchain-Based Skill Credentialing System idea that they built the project on and attended the 36-hr Hackathon. We are proud of this achievement of the students from UVCE.

The Registrar of UVCE approached UVCEGA to assist student Rohit Pawar in managing expenses for his travel to Italy in November 2025, where he would present a paper at an International Conference. Recognizing the importance of encouraging academic excellence and global exposure, UVCEGA agreed to extend its support by covering his flight expenditure (50K). Post his presentation, we asked him to share his experience with other students by organizing a simple seminar via MARVEL.

### **UVCE Boys Hostel Visit**

On February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2026 we had organized “UVCE Boys Hostel Visit” so that we will be able to witness the present scenario personally. Around 25 alumni from various batches joined us to go down the memory lane by walking through the corridors of the hostel and interact with the students staying there.



A vision to waterproof the Old Hostel Block’s roof, initiated by the 1984 Batch alumni and led by UVCEGA Vice President Lt. Sukumar. The work ensured that leakages into the rooms were stopped, addressing an absolute need of the hour. This section of the renovation was completed in May 2025, and a total of 3 Lakhs was spent towards this initiative. Also, the

effort followed the opening of the new canteen building for students, further enhancing hostel life. We wanted to create awareness about the same among alumni and see what can be done to improve the standard of living at hostel.

Many walked straight to their old rooms, filled with joy at revisiting their hostel days, and expressed happiness that UVCEGA was working to improve the hostel spaces.

The hostel wardens, associates, and the newly appointed deputy warden, Prof. K P Guruswamy, welcomed the alumni warmly. Everyone gathered in the canteen space and alumni shared stories with students and encouraged the students to share their concerns and listened to them and engaged in heartfelt conversations.

We were happy to help create a platform for hostel students to interact with alumni, which gave everyone the opportunity to first-hand understand the challenges students face in their day-to-day hostel life.

## Career Sutra

On 14th February 2026, UVCE Graduates Association (UVCEGA), in collaboration with the Training and Placement Office, organized the first-ever edition of Career Sutra, a dedicated platform designed to bring alumni experience directly to students preparing to build their careers and step into the professional world.



The idea for Career Sutra emerged organically from continued engagement with the 2000 batch following their reunion. Hosted at the Lecture Complex with one-on-one mentoring sessions at the Rock Garden, more than 30 alumni volunteered their time and over 340 students registered to participate. The program featured three structured sessions with four focused panels spanning IT Products, IT Services, Core Engineering, and Startups. The diversity of experience ensured that students could gain exposure to multiple career trajectories rather than a single narrative of success. Alumni spoke candidly about their journeys about interviews that did not go as planned, about skills they wished they had developed earlier, about transitions between roles and industries, and about the mindset required to grow sustainably in a competitive environment

Between the formal sessions, the Rock Garden became a space for deeper engagement. Students shortlisted through a preparatory quiz during the break had the opportunity for one-on-one interactions with alumni. They came prepared with specific questions about technical preparation, role clarity, domain shifts, higher studies, and long-term career growth. Alumni responded not as distant achievers, but as seniors who once stood in the same classrooms. Lunch, organized by UVCEGA, allowed conversations to continue informally.

We learned that structured alumni engagement can create measurable impact. We recognized the importance of bringing in even greater diversity of industries and experiences in future editions. We saw the potential for Career Sutra to evolve into an **annual flagship initiative**, and perhaps eventually into a sustained mentorship ecosystem that supports students beyond a single day of interaction.

From the perspective of the UVCEGA Executive Committee, Career Sutra represents more than an event successfully conducted, it represents the beginning of a culture where alumni engagement is intentional, organized, and deeply aligned with student growth. When alumni return with clarity of purpose and students respond with preparation and humility, the institution as a whole becomes stronger.



## Inauguration of new MARVEL Lab space

The new space for the Marvel Lab was officially inaugurated with a ribbon-cutting ceremony by UVCE Director, Prof. Subasish Tripathy, alongside Chief Guests Mrs. Anuradha T.K. and Mrs. Viji Ranganna. Mr. Adrian, a UVCEGA Executive Committee member, welcomed the gathered alumni, faculty, and students, expressing gratitude for their presence at this milestone event. Following the traditional lamp-lighting

ceremony to mark the launch, the chief guests and alumni interacted with students, who demonstrated the lab's key projects and accomplishments from the past four and a half years.

In the journey toward the inauguration, we faced many challenges such as securing permissions, allocating the new space for Marvel, setting up partitions, electrical fittings and carefully moving equipment to make room ready.

The idea was to club it with Scholarships Award Ceremony and we used it as a catalyst to accelerate the work around setting up the new space for Marvel and relocate the current lab so that it will speed up the process and help students get the space faster.



## UVCEGA Scholarships 2024-25: Fostering Student Potential through Alumni Support

As part of our continued commitment to student welfare and academic empowerment, the UVCE Graduates Association successfully executed the 2025–26 UVCEGA Scholarships Program, marking yet another year of meaningful impact. This is the **15th year** of supporting the students via the scholarships and with great happiness, we announce that cumulatively it crossed the **1 Crore amount** worth of scholarships to around **750+ students**.

This year, we received nearly 350+ applications, out of which 150 students were shortlisted for interviews. A panel of 30 alumni volunteers conducted the interview process, ultimately selecting 74 deserving students for scholarship awards. The selection process upheld transparency, meritocracy, and a strong commitment to inclusivity across all departments.

The milestone event offered attendees a poignant opportunity to revisit familiar lecture halls and the iconic campus quadrangle, rekindling fond memories of shared ambitions, early aspirations, and enduring friendships. UVCEGA was glad to be assisting them in organizing this reunion, though the bulk of the management was taken up by the alumni themselves.

The celebration commenced with an engaging reception, followed by a ceremonial campus tour during which alumni planted tree saplings and gathered for commemorative group photographs. A key highlight of the proceedings was the felicitation of former faculty members, who were formally honored with traditional shawls and mementos in recognition of their dedicated service. Demonstrating their continued commitment to the institution, the Class of 2000 pledged a contribution of ₹13 lakh to the UVCE Graduates’ Association to fund future student welfare initiatives.



**Decade Reunion – Batch of 2015**



Recognizing that even a decade apart can feel like a lifetime, the 2014 batch reunion was a joyful and spontaneous celebration. The 2015 batch reunion was held on October 12th, 2025. Organized on short notice, around 25 alumni returned to campus to relive their college days, capturing photos and sharing stories. The celebrations continued over lunch at Century Club, where laughter echoed and memories flowed. The enthusiasm was evident, with many signing up for UVCEGA membership and expressing interest in more such alumni gatherings.

## Infrastructure Support

UVCEGA remains committed to supporting the institution's infrastructure needs through collaborative and transparent engagement with college leadership. While broader plans require ongoing dialogue, we are open to executing focused projects that are mutually agreed upon and jointly monitored by college representatives and the UVCEGA team. Our contributions can take the form of financial assistance or facilitation of resources based on specific, prioritized requirements.

Some of the Key Initiatives Undertaken:

### UVCE Boys' Hostel Waterproofing Project:



Spearheaded by UVCEGA Vice President Lt. Sukumar Rao (Retd.), this critical project was successfully executed between May 4 and June 10, 2025. We had mentioned the same during the previous AGM and promised to complete it in an efficient manner. Undertaken in close coordination with the college administration, the initiative aimed to improve living conditions for students. The

Director of UVCE provided full support throughout the process, ensuring timely and effective completion. Most of the funds were raised by the 1984 Mechanical batch and the remaining managed by UVCEGA. The project stands as a testament to UVCEGA's dedication to enhancing campus infrastructure.

### UVCE Boys' Hostel Old Block Renovation Project:

With the roof fixed, the next target was the hostel rooms, the corridor and the external walls. We decided to sponsor this task from the UVCEGA. Rough estimate of 20K per room renovation was planned and we had organized a "Hostel Meetup" to make an awareness drive for the alumni community, which helped us to get fresh funding for the project. We did a number of social media campaigns to make the alumni community aware of the progress we are making in respect of the project. We were able to raise around 10 Lakhs towards this initiative and remaining 8 Lakhs was funded by UVCEGA. The entire project is completed and the hostel is handed over officially to the college authorities in May 2026.



The finances will be divided between this year and next year.

UVCEGA Vice President Lt. Sukumar Rao (Retd.) and Execom Member Dr Paul Vizhian monitored the project on a regular basis and made sure it was successfully completed within a span of 4 months (January to May, 2026).

### **Water filter for UVCE Boys' Hostel:**

The UVCE Boys Hostel houses 900+ students, but the water filter was just one of 100LPH capacity. This was a concern mentioned during the Hostel meet organized by UVCEGA and one of the alumni from 1965 batch, MR. Venkata Subba Rao took keen interest and with the intent to give back, donated the funds required for the Water filter. We could install a new 100LPH water filter at the hostel, much to the relief of the students staying in the old block. This expense also will be shown in the upcoming financial year.

### **Expansion of MARVEL Lab to new Space:**

We inaugurated the new space for Marvel Lab on 28th March 2026, marking a significant milestone in the 5 years journey of MARVEL. The move into a larger facility opens up fresh opportunities for students. UVCEGA facilitated this transition by setting up partitions, completing electrical work, and getting the basic necessities required for the lab to function. A total of 2.5 lakhs was invested to make the space ready for the students to learn, innovate and build.

### **Water Filter Servicing in the Main Campus:**

The water filter at the college campus was neglected with no maintenance from a long time. Luckily, it was brought to the notice of UVCEGA in the right time, before it could cause any serious health hazard. The necessary repairs/maintenance routine was carried out after getting the permissions and the facility was opened for use in May 2026. The timely maintenance also extended the lifespan and efficiency of the campus infrastructure, reflecting UVCEGA's commitment to practical, high impact support. Around 30K was spent for this purpose and this too will be shown in the upcoming financial year.

### **College Website Management:**

UVCEGA has consistently supported the maintenance and upkeep of the college's official website, including hosting and associated technical costs. Initially managed by VisionUVCE for over three years, the responsibility was transitioned to UVCEGA in the past six years. Ensuring a functional and updated digital presence continues to be a priority, serving as a vital communication channel for the college community.

These initiatives reflect UVCEGA's hands-on approach in addressing critical infrastructure needs and enhancing the campus experience for both students and stakeholders.

## **Alumni Engagement & Student Support Initiatives**

### **UVCE MeetNGreet**

UVCEGA continued its informal "UVCE MeetNGreet" sessions across various Bengaluru locations to foster connections among alumni, students, and faculty. These location-based gatherings—held at venues like

BookBrahma event at St John Auditorium, Koramangala; Cake Exhibition at Palace Grounds, Mekhri Circle; HMT Heritage Museum near Jalahalli —serve as relaxed networking opportunities and help strengthen community ties. While fewer meetups were held this year due to other priorities, we remain committed to expanding these local engagements.



### Online Alumni Meetings

Replacing monthly meetings, UVCEGA initiated *Quarterly Open Meetings* to keep alumni informed about key developments and upcoming initiatives. Due to various reasons, we had done only couple of meetings. These sessions are open to all alumni and encourage wider participation and volunteering.

### UVCE Mentorship Program

Launched for 2026–27, the *Mentorship Program* offers structured, one-on-one guidance to students over a ten-month period. Alumni mentors support students in career planning, skill development, and confidence building. Monthly check-ins and resume submissions ensure consistent engagement. We extend our gratitude to the alumni mentors who volunteered for this impactful initiative.

### Benevity Partnership

In 2023–24, UVCEGA partnered with **Benevity**, a global corporate giving platform, enabling alumni working in partner organizations to make tax-compliant donations. We’ve continued to receive contributions through this channel and aim to build further momentum in the coming year.

### Placement Support (Campus Recruitment)

Alumni continue to play a pivotal role in strengthening campus recruitment at UVCE. For the 2025–26 academic year, alumni helped facilitate placement opportunities with companies such as **LightMetrics Technologies, Broadridge Financial Solutions, Greaves Electric Mobility, BEL, Fivetran, Extreme Networks, and Target**. It’s a chance to know about the cutting-edge ideas which are transformed into practical products and what it really takes to bridge the gap between academics and industry. This initiative was mainly conceptualized by the alumni from 2000 batch, after their reunion. Until now, we have 5 Sessions organized with different speakers across various domains. This led to the other initiative – Career Sutra, mentioned earlier.



## Unnathi – Higher Education Awareness

The *Unnathi* initiative connects current students with alumni who have pursued postgraduate studies in India and abroad. Through interactive sessions, alumni share practical insights on applications, scholarships, and career paths. These sessions are hosted online and promoted widely for maximum reach. ## Placement Bootcamp

On **September 27, 2025**, VisionUVCE conducted a *Placement Bootcamp* for 3rd-year students. With over **150 participants**, the sessions covered resume building, interview strategies, and placement trends, equipping students with practical readiness for recruitment. A 3-hour session was well-received by the students where many of them asked queries and clarified their doubts.

## Other Initiatives


